Background

- The Commission approves Advisory Committee Assignments each January and throughout the year as needed.
- At the December 14, 2023, meeting, Commissioners approved having five Advisory Committees – Executive, Public Education and Outreach, Fiscal, Public Policy, and Program and Evaluation, and having two members on each committee.





Staff Recommendation

Staff drafted three recommendations (options), which were dependent on who would be approved as vice chair (and to provide an equitable distribution on how many Advisory Committees members were assigned to), Commissioner interest and expertise, and maintaining diversity of appointee membership across Advisory Committees (i.e., each Advisory Committee consisting of no more than one appointee from the Governor, the Assembly Speaker, the Senate President Pro Tempore, and Ex Officio designee).
